Purpose	To outline the circumstances in which donations may be made to an eligible recipient.
Status	Administrative - Statutory

Policy

Commitment

The Shire is committed to recognising the value of charitable organisations within the local community and will provide assistance where appropriate.

Eligibility

Priority for assistance will be given to requests where:

- Applicant is a not-for-profit incorporated organisation and is based in, or has a visible presence or significant impact in either Peppermint Grove or immediately adjacent local government districts;
- Applicant can demonstrate that the funded project will provide an on-going benefit to Peppermint Grove residents;
- Funding is required for a new initiative or a significant one-off project with evidence of other funding sources having been pursued (successfully or otherwise);
- If donation is for an event, entry to the event is free of charge to Peppermint Grove residents to attend or participate.



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Council will consider donations that meet the eligibility criteria on a case-by-case basis and will make an annual budget provision for donations. The CEO is authorised to approve donations up to \$1000 subject to consultation with the councillors. Request over \$1000 will be presented to council.
